- PURPOSE:** The Stop the Hate! program prepares college and high school faculty, administrators, staff, and students to facilitate training programs designed to prevent bias incidents and hate crimes on campus. According to the FBI, college campuses are the third most common location where hate crimes occur in the United States. This program will empower campus communities to create a safe place for students and staff to work and learn.
- This program is very interactive and includes 12 learning modules that include hate crime law, bias incident awareness, victim support, hate crime offender motivation, trainer techniques, and much more.
- The course facilitators are experienced trainers from organizations including Napa Valley College, the Association of Colleges and Universities International, Anti-Defamation League, Matthew Shepard Foundation, Center for the Prevention of Hate Violence, and the Southern Poverty Law Center.
